KEEPING TALENT IN THE TERRITORIES



Spanish National Program



Main magnitudes:

- 1000 students from 39 universities
- 3.2M€ budget
- **Balanced representation** of women and men in the program (60% women and 40% men)
- More tan 400 municipalities involved
- 21% of students do their internship in a autonomous community different from where they studied
- Public and private participation (54% public companies and 46% private companies)
- Students from 157 diferent studies
