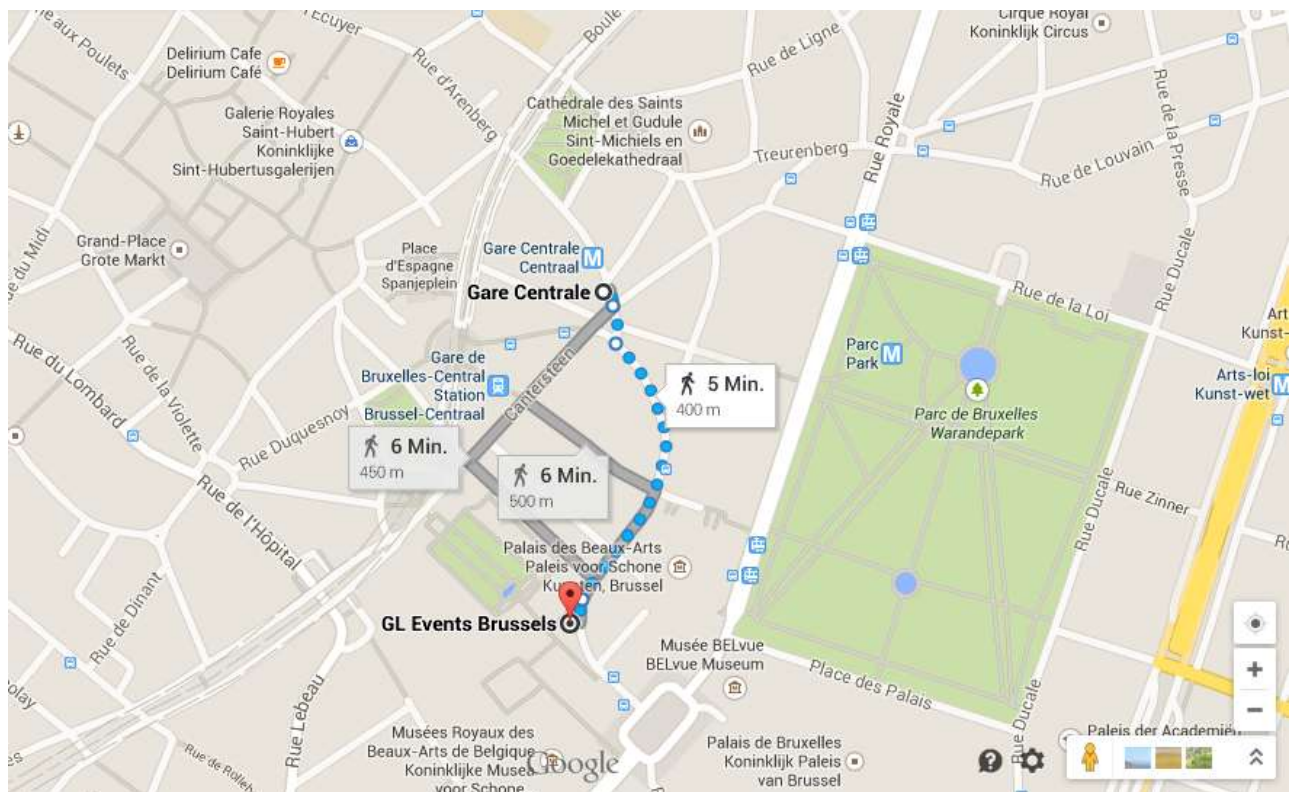

How to get there:

- **By rail:**

SQUARE is just across the way from Brussels Central rail station with national and international high-speed connections to London, Paris, Amsterdam, Köln etc.

- **From Airport**

From Brussels International Airport to Brussels Central rail station:

From Brussels International Airport you can take the train to Brussels Central rail station. Trains from the airport run approximately from 05:30 in the morning until midnight. There are approx. 4 trains per hour. The total travel time from the airport to Brussels Central rail station is approximately 20 minutes.

From Charleroi airport to Brussels Central rail station:

Charleroi Airport offers buses to Brussels Midi train station. There is a bus every 30 minutes, from 04:00 to 20:45 (until 20:00 at weekends). The journey time is approximately one hour. From the Brussels Midi there are trains to Brussels Central rail station departing every five minutes.
