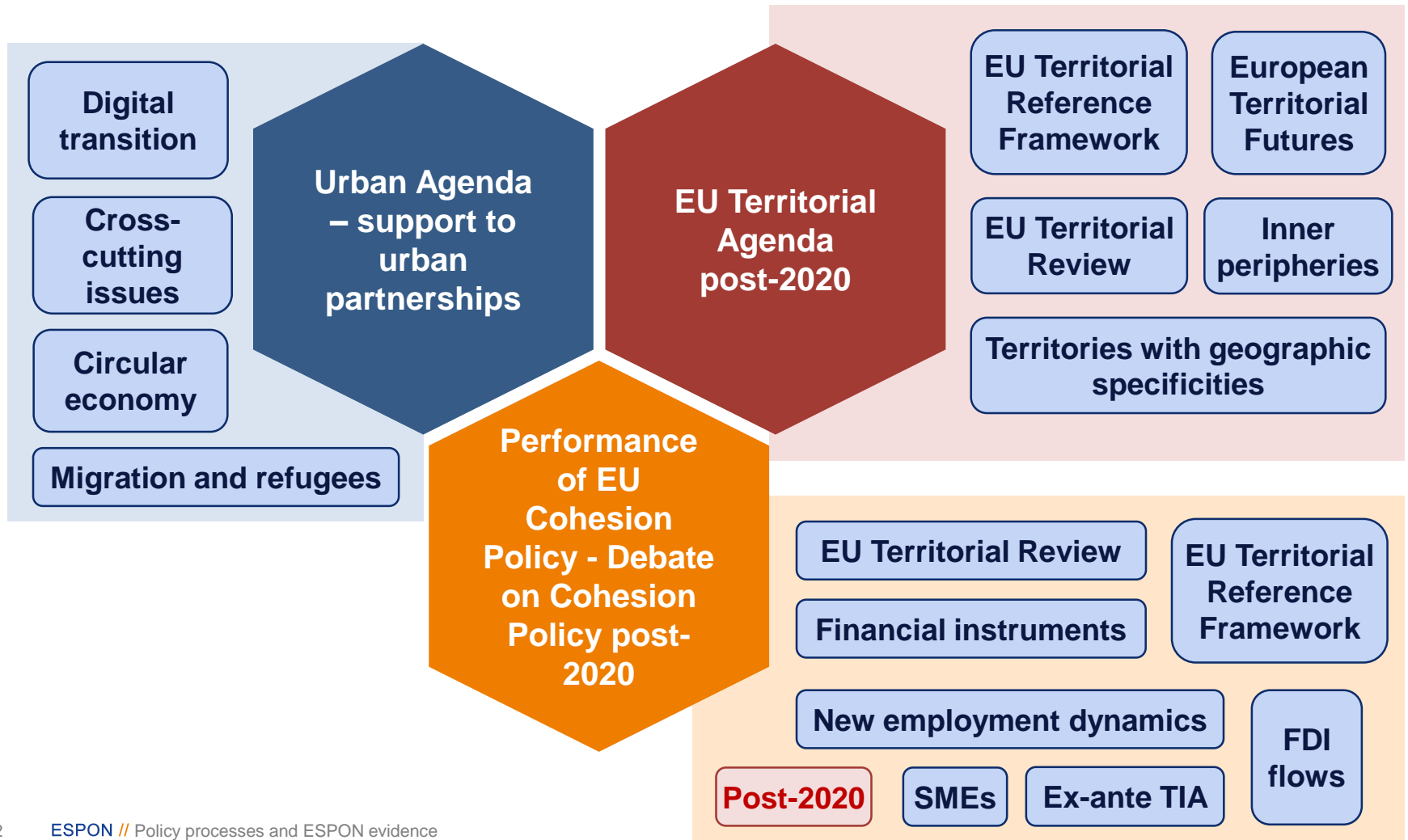

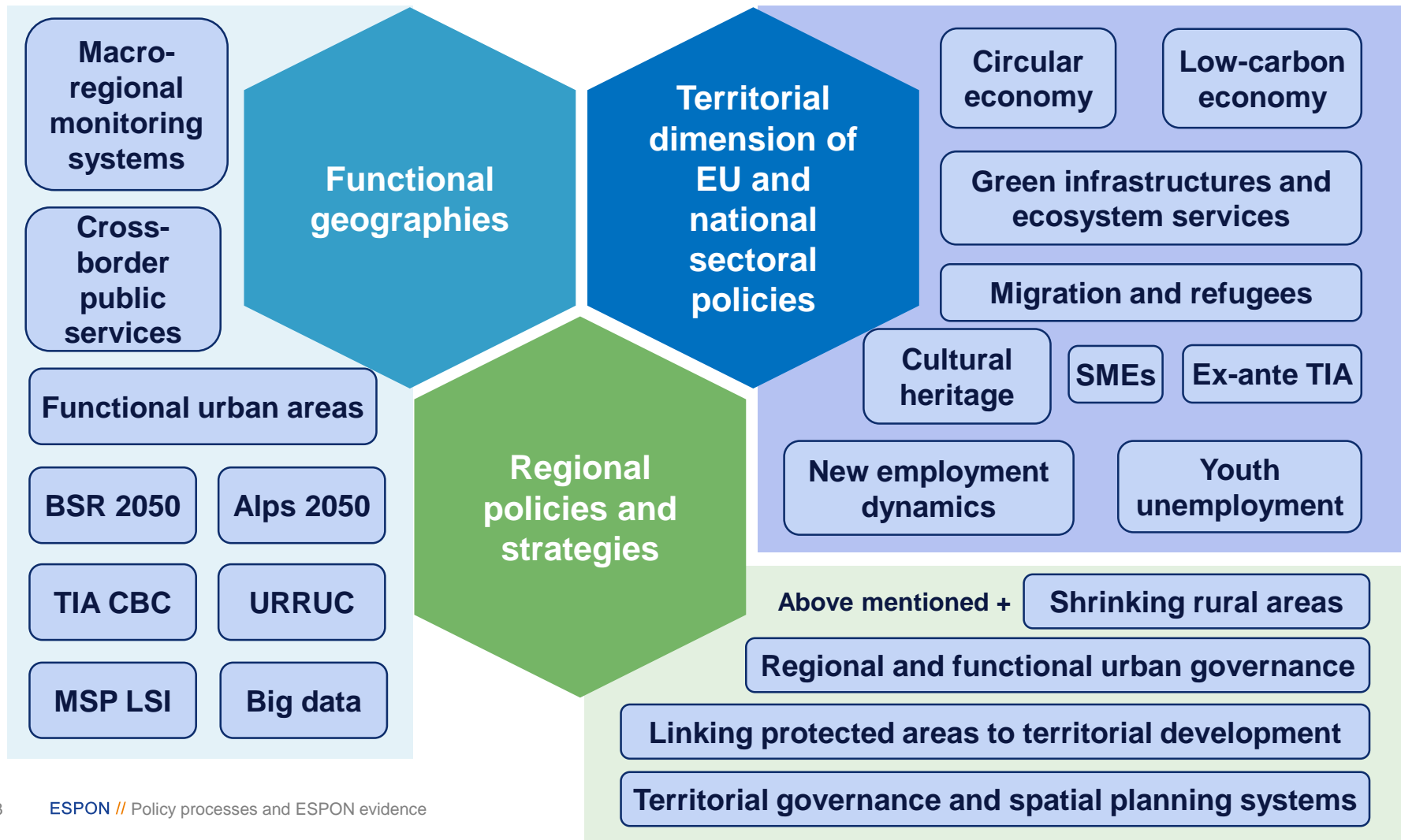

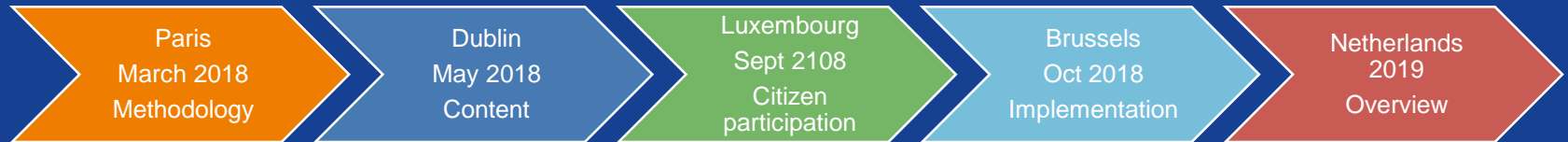

Building the next generation of research on territorial development

- To take place on 14 November 2018 in London
- Aimed at promoting **the use of new methodologies** and concepts developed to support a territorial dimension in policy development
- The focus will be on methods and concepts that are:
 - able to capture territorial interrelations, functional areas and territorial development beyond static administrative units;
 - able to monitor and measure integrated territorial development; and
 - using new data sources and tools for territorial analysis

Peer learning workshops
