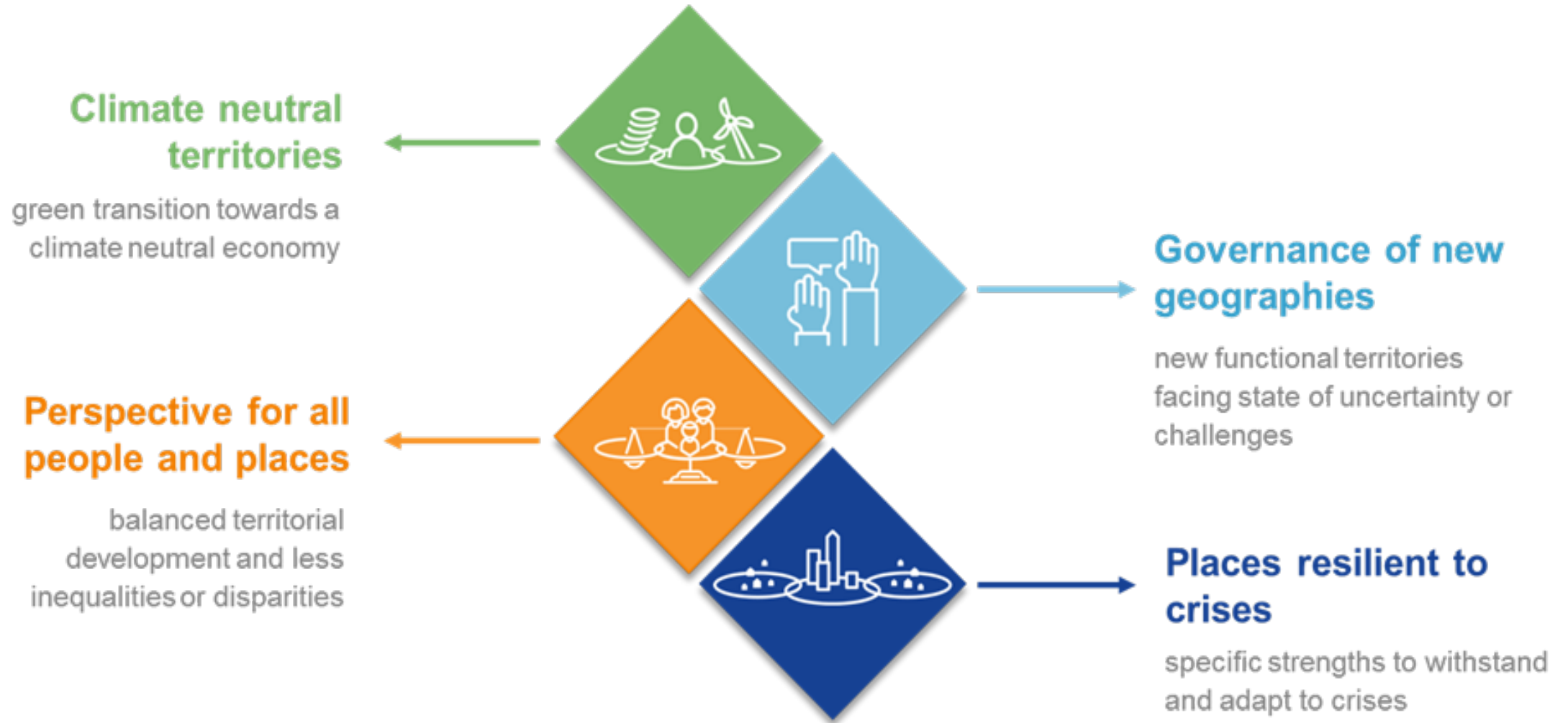


The ESPON 2030 Programme
