



THE RATIONALE: The Spanish Partnership Agreement

- > High degree of urbanisation in Spain
- 80% of the population in urban areas that occupy
 20% of the territory
- Medium urban areas play a key role for polycentric development
- Over 60% out of 8.131 municipalities in Spain have less than 1.000 inhabitants (INE, 2022)


➤ Challenge: internal territorial unbalances




In the '60s rural shrinkage prevailed but it is now clear that small and medium cities also lose population

The 2021-2027 programming period in Spain

Policy Objective 5 in Spain Pluriregional programme of Spain

SO 5.1: Integrated urban development 8% ERDF

EUR 1,9 billion (14% of the Programme)

Three tipologies of urban areas:

- -big cities >75.000 inhab.
- **-medium cities** 20.000 to 75.000 inhab. (40% to 60% of funds)
- -Functional urban areas min. 20.000 inhab. (5% to 15% of funds)

SO 5.2: Territories art. 174 of the Treaty
